Dr. Susan Pritchard and Michael Liu discussed wildfire management, assessments, conditions and ecology of the local area. David Gottula and Samuel Israel followed by discussing OCEC's current and future fire mitigation efforts and David introduced the new Fire Safety Shutoffs segment of the OCEC Fire Mitigation Plan.
