RATES WILL INCREASE ON OCTOBER 1ST

With the release of the final wholesale power and transmission rates from Bonneville Power Administration for the period of October 1, 2025 – September 30, 2028, the OCEC Board approved a 5% kWh Energy Rate increase for the General Service G1, G2, G3, G4, and Second Meter rate classes effective October 1, 2025. This change reflects rising costs in wholesale power supply and delivery. The updated rates will ensure OCEC continues to provide safe, reliable power to our Members.

Look for simple ways to boost indoor comfort without running your heating and cooling system. Use ceiling fans and open windows on breezy days to ventilate your home. On cooler days, add a layer of clothing and avoid running the heat.
