



July 26, 2021 – OPERATIONS UPDATE – CUB CREEK 2 FIRE & CEDAR CREEK FIRE

CUB CREEK 2 FIRE: OCEC crews worked through the week on the rebuild process for members affected by the Cub Creek 2 Fire that started on Friday, July 16th. The 62 members in the North Chewuch/8 Mile area had power restored on Friday, July 24th.

CEDAR CREEK FIRE: At the direction of the fire Incident Command, OCEC crews de-energized power to 29 members in the Left Fork Wolf Creek Rd area on Sunday, July 25th. This afternoon we were able to restore power to 18 members; the 11 members west of 80 Left Fork Wolf Creek Rd are still without power. OCEC is in direct contact with Incident Command and will assess the area for any potential damage when it is safe to do so. This area will remain off until the Incident Command gives the approval for the crew to enter the area safely, perform any necessary work, and re-energize.
